On 02/06/12 at approximately 12:04 A.M., I Officer Parker was patrolling on fifth street passing 708 South Fifth Street, First Baptist Church, when I noticed a black passenger car parked in the parking lot with no lights on and occupied at least one time. I made a block and pulled up behind the vehicle bearing license plate TX: In notified Denton County Communications that I was out with a suspicious vehicle at above location. I met and spoke with the driver who stated he and his g/f had an argument and he was in Tioga trying to get home. I immediately detected an odor of alcohol coming from the subjects person, I then noticed an open bottle of wine in the passenger side of the vehicle. Officer Bishop poured out the remaining wine in the wine bottle and inventoried the vehicle which was towed by EJ's towing. I transported Mr. Travis to Denton County Jail where he was booked in for public intoxication.
