Matter is called for hearing.

SWORN AND TESTIFYING: Maria Beatriz Oaxaca (through certified Spanish Interpreter Elsa Anaya).

Court contacts Bruce Beresford-Redman via conference call in open court. After hearing from the parties in court and based on the oral nomination by Bruce Beresford-Redman, father of the minor children, the court grants temporary guardianship of minors Camila and Alec to the paternal grandparents, Juanita and David Beresford-Redman. Temporary letters are granted to May 20, 2010.

Court orders the children's passports, both United States and Brazilian, be surrendered to the court to be held by the clerk of the court until further order of the court. The minors' US passports are currently with Carla Burgos Van Bastelaar, and Alex's Brazilian passport is currently with David Beresford-Redman. Efforts are to be made to have Janee surrender Camila's Brazilian passport to the court.

Carla Burgos. Van Bastelaar and her son are to have reasonable visits with minors Camila and Alex in the Beresford-Redman family home when the paternal grandparents are present. Maria Beatriz Oaxaca is to have liberal visits with the minors in their family home, including overnight visits, as well as visits and activities outside of the family home. The temporary guardians are not restricted on who may visit with the minors.

The minors are not to be removed from Los Angeles County without a prior court order.
