Comes your Petitioner, Dave Edward Holloway, and upon information and belief,  
respectfully shows unto your Honor the following facts:

1. Petitioner invokes the equity jurisdiction of this court.

2. Natalee Ann Holloway, a single, female Caucasian, who was born in the State of  
Alabama on October 21, 1986, disappeared on May 30, 2005, and at that time was a resident of  
Jefferson County, Alabama. Natalee Ann Holloway's social security number is [REDACTED]

3. The names, relationships, ages, conditions, and residences of the widow,  
heirs, and distributees of said decedent's estate are as follows:

4. Said decedent left assets in Jefferson County, Alabama. All of the properties, real  
and personal, of which said decedent died seized and possessed are estimated to be worth  
approximately \$500.00 and probably not more.

5. Said death has been known for more than five days; and said decedent left  
no Last Will and Testament.

6. Natalee Ann Holloway disappeared on May 30, 2005, during a high school graduation trip to Aruba. Holloway was scheduled to fly home but failed to appear for her flight. Holloway's packed luggage and passport were found in her hotel room. She was last seen by her classmates outside Carlos'n Charlies's in a car with locals Joran van der Sloot and brothers Deepak and Satish Kalpoe. Van der Sloot and the Kalpoes were each arrested more than once on suspicion of involvement in Holloway's disappearance and were each released without charge after each arrest.

7. Aruban investigators conducted an extensive search for Holloway with the help of volunteers, special agents from the FBI, Dutch soldiers and Dutch Air Force F-16 aircraft. In addition to the ground search, divers examined the ocean floor for evidence of Holloway's body. The searches were unsuccessful

8. On December 18, 2007, Aruban prosecutors announced that the case would be closed. The case was reopened on February 1, 2008, after receiving video footage of Joran van der Sloot making statements that Holloway died on the morning of May 30, 2005, and that he disposed of her body. See attached affidavit of Dave Holloway.

9. Petitioner requests that this court enter an Order on Legal Presumption of Death.

**WHEREFORE**, your petitioner prays that your Honor enter an Order on the Legal Presumption of Death of Natalee Ann Holloway.

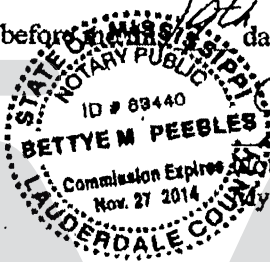

I, DAVE HOLLOWAY, under the penalty of perjury, swears to the truth of the following:

1. I am the natural father of Natalee Ann Holloway.
2. On Thursday, May 26, 2005, Natalee and a number of a high school classmates traveled to Aruba to celebrate their high school graduation.
3. At approximately 1:00 a.m. on May 30, 2005, Natalee was last seen leaving Carlos & Charlies bar with Joran van der Sloot, Deepak Kalpoe and Satish Kalpoe.
4. Natalee was never heard from, or seen, again since early morning May 30, 2005.
5. In their accounts of their contact with Natalee, the three above-mentioned individuals gave fabricated statements, contradicted their own statements, and contradicted the statements of one another. In 2008, Joran van der Sloot was secretly recorded by a Dutch crime show where he stated Natalee died on the beach and her body was disposed in the ocean. In 2010, he was recorded by the FBI and Aruban police and reportedly stated that Natalee died accidentally and was buried under the foundation of a home in Aruba. He later recanted the location, however, during many of his prior stories he indicates that Natalee's death was accidental.
6. At Mountain Brook High School Natalee graduated with an "A" average and was an honor student 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade. She was Class treasurer, a member of Future Business Leaders of America, Historian, National Honor Society, Nature Helpers Club, Student Government Representative, Spanish Club member, Spanish Honor Society Member, and a member of Spartan Pride and dance member of the Dorians.
7. Prior to her trip to Aruba, Natalee had no medical issues, psychological issues or family issues or concerns.
8. The security cameras at the Holiday Inn where Natalee was staying verified that Natalee never returned to the hotel between the time she was seen leaving Carlos & Charlies, to the time she missed her flight. Her passport, packed luggage, camera and cellular phone were still in her room.

9. There has been no credit card, bank, cell phone or other form of activity or communication since May 30, 2005 that suggests Natalee may still be alive.
10. Despite a well-publicized one million (\$1,000,000.00) reward for information leading to Natalee's whereabouts, and a manned hotline, no viable tips, leads or sighting of Natalee have been received.
11. The Aruban and Dutch police have reportedly conducted an exhaustive investigation, both in Aruba and abroad, with no viable leads indicating Natalee may still be alive. On or about June 11, 2005, our FBI contact on the island of Aruba indicated the investigation turned from a missing person case to a homicide investigation. That position has not changed.
12. The primary suspect in Natalee's case is 23 year old Joran van der Sloot. He has been held in a Peruvian prison since June 2010 over the murder of 21-year-old Stephany Flores. The Dutch national is accused of robbing and killing Flores in his Lima hotel room in May 2010.
13. Based on all of the above facts and information, it is my firm, however, painful, belief that my daughter Natalee is deceased, and not a runaway.
