In Re: Action for Defamation and Libel

I have received a copy of an email you sent to Monica Kacsur on July 12, 2011.

In this email, you stated, in part "We were wondering if there have been more payments and if the notice is real and if the amount is correct."

I consider this, as interpreted under the laws of the State of California, a communication of a statement that makes a claim, expressly stated or implied to be factual that gives a negative image of our company as being allegedly untrustworthy and dishonest.

I would also consider this type of conduct and communication an intentional interference with prospective business advantage.

My company is hereby demanding that you cease and desist contacting business associates of my company and me and painting the picture that we are someone dishonest or "cooking" the books in regards to the Lohan video proceeds. This will not be tolerated, period.

You do not have any legal right to contact the AP and suggest I've been ripping you off which is what you've done.

This activity must stop immediately. I believe my reputation has already been put into question in their eyes by your actions. I am therefore alleging you have caused damages. I am asking that you refrain from this type of conduct. You have received timely payment on all proceeds on this project, period. There's no two ways about it. Kindly govern yourself accordingly.
