**You Cannot Have Guns or Firearms**

You cannot own, have, possess, buy or try to buy, receive or try to receive, or otherwise get a gun while this Order is in effect. If you do, you can go to jail and pay a \$1,000 fine. You must sell to a licensed gun dealer or turn in to police any guns or firearms that you have or control in accordance with item ⑧ above. The court will require you to prove that you did so. If you do not obey this Order, you can be charged with a crime.

**Instructions for Law Enforcement**

This Order is effective when made. It is enforceable anywhere in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, all tribal lands, and all U.S. territories and shall be enforced as if it were an order of that jurisdiction by any law enforcement agency that has received the Order, is shown a copy of the Order, or has verified its existence on the California Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (CLETS). If the law enforcement agency has not received proof of service on the restrained person, and the restrained person was not present at the court hearing, the agency shall advise the restrained person of the terms of the Order and then shall enforce it. - 1 10. Bruce was aware of the close relationship I shared with Monica. Bruce was  
2 aware that I knew about the extramarital affair and well as the recent activities  
3 between he and his father regarding their joint banking account. Monica made it  
4 known to Bruce that she was relaying everything that he was doing to me. This made  
5 Bruce extremely angry at me.
- 6 11. Several weeks before their trip to Mexico, Monica told me that she was going to  
7 withdraw a lot of money from their joint account. In the following several days, she  
8 withdrew the money, she changed the locks of their house and threw Bruce's clothes  
9 in trashbags and out onto the street.
- 10 12. She then took her children to Hawaii for several days to figure out how to handle  
11 her martial problems and decide whether or not to leave Bruce.
- 12 13. Bruce constantly called Monica in Hawaii, trying to convince her to take him  
13 back.
- 14 14. When Monica and the kids returned from Hawaii, Bruce was at the house.
- 15 15. Despite all of their problems, Monica cared deeply for Bruce and wanted to have  
16 her family together. So, when Bruce suggested that they go on a family trip to  
17 Mexico, she agreed. Bruce made the reservations, he chose the hotel and completely  
18 planned the trip.
- 19 16. I told her not to go on the trip because it was not where she wanted to travel to  
20 and I was extremely suspicious that he would make travel arrangements since in their  
21 eleven years of marriage, he had never planned a vacation or made the travel  
22 arrangements, Monica always did.
- 23 17. Monica called me on April 30th, the day before they left for their trip to Mexico.  
24 That was the last time that I spoke to her.
- 25 18. Since her death, I have been running the restaurant with the help of her sisters,  
26 Carla and Jeane. Bruce and his father, David, have never had anything to do with  
27 Zabumba. I would approximate that Bruce has been to the restaurant less than once  
28 a month for the seven years that I have been working there. Bruce's father, David,  
has been to the restaurant less than four times per year in all of the time that I have  
worked there.
- 19 19. On May 29, 2010, at 10:00 p.m., I was working at Zabumba. The restaurant was  
20 closed that day as I was preparing food for the memorial service we were holding for  
21 Monica the following day. The doors were shut, the lights outside were turned off  
22 and the sign said closed. We were not open for business. There were only a couple  
23 of us in the restaurant at the time. My car, which is known to Bruce and his father,  
24 was the only car parked next to Zabumba. Further, neither Bruce nor his father,  
25 David, would have any need either business or personal for being at the restaurant.  
26 Monica's sisters were recently granted temporary guardianship over the restaurant.
- 27 20. I was preparing the food in the kitchen when Bruce's father opened the front gate  
28 of the restaurant and also opened the door to the restaurant. He walked into the  
restaurant with his right hand inside of his shirt, as if he was hiding a weapon.

1 21. He asked another one of the people helping us that day, in a very threatening  
2 way, "Where is Norma? I want to talk to Norma." He was very demanding. The  
3 employee came into where I was standing and was literally shaking. She told me that  
4 Bruce's father was there looking for me.


5 22. Bruce's father demanded that he speak to me. He looked at me, with his hand in  
6 his shirt, as if he had a weapon. I started to scream and yell, "Get out of here. I don't  
7 want this guy here. I don't want to see this guy." The way he was holding something  
8 inside of his shirt and looking at me so menacingly, I honestly believed that he  
9 wanted to kill me.

10 23. We immediately called the police and made a report. The report number is  
11 100529005757. I went to the Los Angeles Police Department, Pacific Division.  
12 The officers at the station explained to me that I needed to come to court and request  
13 a restraining order.

14 24. I am afraid of him and fear that he will harm me because of all of the information  
15 I have regarding his son and Monica. He has caused me severe emotional distress as  
16 I keep reliving the moment when he was staring me down with his hand in his shirt  
17 as if he was hiding a weapon. I truly thought that he was going to shoot me. I fear  
18 that if I do not have a restraining order against him, he will attempt to harm me in  
19 some way. If this order is imposed, David Beresford-Redman will still be able to get  
20 to his home and go about his daily business without interruption.


Declaration of Michael Melair

I, Michael Melair, am a witness to this action. If called upon to testify, I could and would testify to the following:

1. My name is Michael Melair and my date of birth is March 20, 1963,
2. I am a friend of Norma Paula De Ahlf. On May 29, 2010, I went to Zabumba to help Norma prepare for Monica’s memorial the following day.
3. At about ten p.m., I was back in the kitchen cleaning some of trays when I heard someone said, “Michael, can you get this guy to leave?” I walked into the front kitchen area when I saw an older man standing there with his right hand in his shirt. It looked to me that he was holding a gun. I immediately became concern that he would physically harm or shoot one of us.
4. I walked up to him and told him that we were closed and he said, “Is Norma here?” He looked around to the kitchen area again repeating, “Is Norma here? I want to talk to Norma.” When he saw her, he stated, “I want to talk to Norma.” During the entire exchange, he had his hand in his shirt as if he was concealing a weapon.
5. Bruce’s father, David, created such panic in the restaurant that everybody started yelling and screaming for him to get out of the restaurant. Bruce’s father, David, left the restaurant soon thereafter. I immediately called 911.
6. There is no doubt in my mind that Bruce’s father, David Beresford-Redman, went to the restaurant to harm Norma. As I told the police, I am not associated with either party in any way but I strongly believe that he had a gun and came into the restaurant with a purpose to do harm to Norma.
