I wanted to add to my brief statement in the request for postponement.


On Nov 1, 2010, while leaving my gym, I sustained a multiple wrist fracture and head laceration in a fall from a concrete step, out of building code regulation, onto a sloping sidewalk. I was rushed to Emergency at Cedars Sinai and then to a surgeon without wrist restructure speciality. After some days, I found the top surgeon in this field, Dr. David Kulber, at Cedars.

Dr. Kulber performed a highly complicated reconstructive surgery on Nov, 15, 2010, placing a 5" long metal plate in my wrist with several pins, one of which protruded from my wrist surprisingly on Tuesday of this week.. Dr Kulber removed this pin plus another one on Tuesday, causing severe pain in the wrist, a new round of antibiotics and pain killers for at least a week, he advised, before a cast could even be contemplated. It apparently takes 3 months for bones to mend to the point of any ability to use the wrist, barring further complications. This is why I have requested an end of Jan, 2011 court date.

I did not realize the 10-day timetable on requesting a delay in the civil court proceedings and hoped I would be sufficiently recovered to be present. This proved not to be possible with the surprise complication earlier this week. I cannot be sure when complete recovery will make it possible for me to gather witnesses and prepare my defense, though I have begun to do this from bed, as I believe the charges against me to be without merit.

Thank you for your patience in this matter. I look forward to defending myself from the spurious charge alleged against me.
