Report Narrative On 5/28/2010 at approx 1154 hrs I was dispatched to assist with a 50-year-old female, unconscious, in the area of [REDACTED]. I responded from [REDACTED] and arrived shortly after medical services had arrived. After I entered the house I first noticed W1/[REDACTED] who was inside of the residence in the front entry way on the telephone. I asked W1/[REDACTED] where the paramedics had gone. He pointed to a room which is to the north of the hallway. I then went to that room. En route to that room through the hallway I passed W2/[REDACTED] who was also present at the house, but not inside of this room.

I went into a room on the north side of this residence and I noticed a white female laying on a bed which was against the north wall. I also noticed multiple paramedics working with S1/King who I later identified via the two witnesses as Shawn King, [REDACTED].

After arriving I asked W2/[REDACTED] if S1/King had any pills or medications that she had been taking, and where those might be. W2/[REDACTED] stated that S1/King's pills would be in her purse, and maybe in the bathroom.

I then noticed on the bed in the area of where the paramedics were working multiple pill bottles all of which were empty on the bed, and I also found other pill bottles in her purse and in the bathroom. The pill bottles are the following: Comprone, Prometrium, Clonazepam, Ambien, Klonopin, Subutex, Cymbalta and Lyrica. Many of the bottles including Ambien, Klonopin and Clonazepam were empty. Some of which had a prescription of thirty others of sixty, all of which were empty, and which had been filled within ten days. Also noticed near S1/King multiple bottles of water, one which was empty, the other one which was partially empty.

I also noticed multiple sheets of paper, other various items such as scriptures, a purse, other various books and multiple pillows. The first page I saw one of the paramedics handed to me stated to me that it was on the bed which appeared to be a note left by the victim. At this time it is unknown whose writing this letter was in, however wording on the letter led me to believe that S1/King had intentionally taken the quantity of pills.

These multiple pages which I recovered are booked into evidence as Items 1, 2, and 3. Items 1 and 3 have two pages, item 2 has one page.

After speaking with W2/[REDACTED] about the pills and asking her to assist me locate the medications which S1/King might be on I then spoke with W1/[REDACTED]. I asked when the last time W1/[REDACTED] had seen S1/King. He stated that he had the previous night at approx 2350 hrs on 5/27/2010. He had been at S1/King's house. He stated that he did not believe anyone else was at the house after he had left at approx 2350 hrs. He returned the following day at approx 1000 hrs. He stated that he saw S1/King on the bed and that she was sleeping. He stated that he thought she must have been tired so he left her and returned at approx 1130 hrs. W1/[REDACTED] was unable to alert S1/King. He attempted to slap her in the face, as well as to put something cold on her face, and she was not revived. After which he called the Provo Police Department.

He then called his wife, W2/[REDACTED], who was not with him when he found her.

W1/[REDACTED] stated that S1/King is always depressed, but she had not mentioned anything that she would want to hurt herself or take her own life.

Shortly after this time paramedics transported S1/King to UVRMC. After transport I continued to speak with W1 and explained to him the purpose for my being there.

I explained to W1 that I had located several pieces of paper which had writing possibly from S1/King indicating that she was leaving, or that she might hurt herself, such as that she wished to be buried in Utah. W1 desired to go to the hospital to check on S1/King.

I was accompanied by Sgt Siufanua in the home after which W1 left. I remained in the home with Sgt Siufanua and left at 1313 hrs at which time I locked the front door as instructed and demonstrated by W1. I did not use any other doors, or move into any other rooms save the bedroom with S1/King and the adjacent bathroom. Also I used the hallways, which is necessary to exit the house through the front door.

After leaving the residence at 1313 hrs I went to the hospital, UVRMC, and met with Officer Smith, 3241, who was assisting the family of the victim. While at the UVRMC the family specifically, W1, expressed desire to read the letters which had been left by the victim.

After getting approval from Sgt Siufanua, 302, I allowed W1 to read the letters which were already enclosed in evidence bags to his family upon his request. After he read the letters I collected them and kept them in my possession until booked into the Provo Police Department evidence.

Attached to this report is a Property Report Form which contains the three items which are the letters which were left on the bed. Further evidence will be booked in upon receiving which will include photographed evidence of the room in which S1/King was found.

Last known status of S1/King was that she was in critical condition at the UVRMC. Further update has not been made thus far.

Nothing further with this report at this time.
