## ARREST – INVESTIGATION REPORT NARRATIVE (CONTINUED)

1. **FIELD SOBRIETY TESTS (FST's):**

2. Prior to Spears being allowed to begin the Field Sobriety Tests (FSTs), the FSTs were demonstrated and explained  
3. in English. The subject was given the opportunity to ask clarifying questions and was not allowed to begin FSTs  
4. until she confirmed she understood each test. All times were taken by the arresting officer's wristwatch. All times  
5. are approximate.

7. **HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:**

8. I observed equal pupil size, equal tracking, and no resting nystagmus in both eyes. I observed a lack of smooth  
9. pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. While attempting to get prior to 45  
10. degrees, Spears related the lights were hurting her head and did not want to continue the test. Spears was unable or  
11. unwilling to follow my finger throughout the test. Spears continued to move her head throughout the test after  
12. being instructed to keep her head still. Spears related she was blind in her left eye, but was able to see my finger.

14. **PRELIMINARY ALCOHOL SCREENING TEST:**

15. I related the PAS Admonishment to Spears, to which she related she would not consent to the test.

17. **OBSERVATIONS PRIOR TO STOP:**

18. On March 4, 2026, at approximately 2048 hours, I was on duty wearing a full CHP tan uniform, driving a fully  
19. marked black and white CHP Patrol Vehicle (p/v, 8858) on Hampshire Road South of US-101, when Ventura  
20. Communications Center (VCC) broadcast a "Be On the Look Out" (BOLO) for a black BMW convertible (s/v)  
21. with a license plate of GC 7927.705 traveling at high speeds and swerving. VCC related the s/v was traveling  
22. northbound on US-101 south of Rancho Road. Officer J. Fong, ID 21461, was in contact with the reporting party  
23. via telephone and was able to obtain an updated location for the s/v. The reporting party wished to remain  
24. anonymous. Officer Fong related the s/v exited onto Pleasant Valley Road and was parked at Woodside Park.  
25. Officer Fong advised dispatch the s/v entered the freeway and was now traveling southbound on US-101. I  
26. acknowledged the information and parked my p/v on the right shoulder of the Borchard Road on-ramp to  
27. southbound US-101. Officer Fong advised the s/v was southbound on US-101 approaching Lynn Road. I entered  
28. southbound US-101 and at approximately 2056 hours, I observed the s/v in the #2 lane southbound US-101 at  
29. Rancho Road. I positioned my p/v directly behind the s/v and observed the s/v left side tires cross into the #1 lane  
30. by approximately 2 feet. The s/v corrected and merged back into the #2 lane. The s/v crossed into the #1 lane  
31. again by approximately 2 feet. The s/v corrected again and continued in the #2 lane. I activated my forward facing  
32. emergency lights to initiate an enforcement stop. The s/v continued to drive in the #2 lane and did not immediately  
33. react to my emergency lights. I activated the p/v's siren to get the driver's attention. After approximately 15  
34. seconds, the s/v began to merge to the right. The s/v passed the Hampshire Road exit and continued southbound on  
35. US-101. The s/v exited onto Westlake Boulevard and turned right. The s/v yielded at the right curb of Westlake  
36. Boulevard, just south of US-101.

1. **OBSERVATIONS AFTER STOP:**

2. I approached the driver side of the s/v and knocked on the window. I observed a sole female occupant seated in the  
3. driver seat of the s/v. The female driver rolled down the driver side window of the s/v. I contacted the female  
4. driver and related the reason for the stop. I requested her driver license and the driver related her license was at her  
5. house. The driver identified herself as Britney Jean Spears, DOB 12/02/1981, by her U.S. Passport. While  
6. speaking to Spears, I detected the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from inside the s/v. Spears  
7. consented to a cursory check of her eyes, during which I observed nystagmus at maximum deviation. Her eyes  
8. were also red and watery, and her pupils were dialated. I instructed Spears to exit the s/v, but she initially refused.  
9. Spears related she had been pranked and harassed in the past and did not want to exit. I informed Spears I smelled  
10. the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from inside the s/v and I wanted to conduct a DUI investigation. Spears  
11. related she wanted to speak to her lawyer and had the right as a woman not to exit her vehicle. Officer Fong  
12. arrived on scene and informed Spears he was the Officer in Charge (OIC). Officer Fong informed Spears she  
13. needed to exit the s/v in order for me to conduct a DUI investigation. After approximately 10 minutes of speaking  
14. to Spears, she finally agreed to exit the s/v. I asked Spears a series of pre-FST questions during which I detected  
15. the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath and person. Her speech was rapid and slurred,  
16. her gait was unsteady, and she was fidgeting with her fingers. I asked Spears if she had consumed an alcoholic  
17. beverage prior to driving, and she related she had one mimosa when she woke up "around 2 PM." I asked Spears if  
18. she felt the effects of the alcohol and she related "No." I asked Spears on a scale of zero to ten, with zero being  
19. completely sober, and ten being the most drunk she has ever been, where she would place her current level of  
20. intoxication. Spears placed her current level of intoxication at "Zero." Spears related, "I could probably drink four  
21. bottles of wine and take care of you, I'm an angel." I asked Spears if she had taken any medications or drugs prior  
22. to driving, and Spears related she had taken 200 mg of Lamictal. I explained and demonstrated a Field Sobriety  
23. Test (FST), but Spears related she did not feel well and did not want to perform any more tests.

25. During my contact with Spears, I observed she had drastic mood swings. Her mood changed from confrontational  
26. and agitated to flamboyant and compliant. She also appeared to speak with a British accent at times.

27.

28. **ARREST:**

29. Based on my training and experience, which consists of 55 hours of DUI investigation, 16 hours of Advanced  
30. Roadside Impaired Driver Enforcement, my observations of her objective signs and symptoms of impairment, her  
31. poor performance on the FST, and her driving, I determined Spears had been driving a motor vehicle under the  
32. combined influence of alcohol and drugs (DUI). Spears was placed under arrest for DUI at 2128 hours. I placed  
33. Spears in handcuffs and placed her in the right front passenger seat of p/v 6920 and fastened her seatbelt. While  
34. conducting a vehicle inventory, Officer Fong located a brown purse that contained a bottle of pills labeled  
35. "Adderall," which were not prescribed to Spears. Officer Fong removed the bottle from the purse and placed it  
36. inside of the s/v. He also observed an empty wine glass in the cup holder between the front driver seat and  
37. passenger seat.

1. **ARREST (continued):**

2. I informed Spears of California Vehicle Code section 23612 (Implied Consent) to which she related she would

3. submit to a chemical breath test. For 15 minutes prior to administering the breath test, Spears did nothing to

4. invalidate the test. At 2143 and 2150 hours, I obtained two breath tests from Spears, with the results of .05%

5. and .06%. Due to suspected drug impairment, I requested Spears submit to a Drug Recognition Evaluation, to

6. which she agreed. Spears was transported to CHP Moorpark Office. Officer C. Baker, ID 437, of the Simi Valley

7. Police Department, conducted a Drug Recognition Evaluation (DRE) and determined Spears was under the

8. influence of a CNS Stimulant. I informed Spears I needed to transport her to Los Robles Medical Center for a

9. blood draw. In an attempt to delay the blood draw, Spears related she needed to use the restroom. While in the

10. restroom, Spears became argumentative and belligerent. I placed Spears in handcuffs and placed her in the right

11. front seat of the p/v. Spears was transported to Los Robles Medical Center, where I informed her of the Drug

12. Admonition to which she agreed to submit to a chemical blood test. On March 5, 2026, at 0035 hours, I observed

13. J. Deleon, R.N. obtain two blood samples of Spears' blood from her left arm. The blood sample was given to me

14. and remained in my possession until it was booked into evidence at the CHP Moorpark Area Office. Spears was

15. then transported to Ventura County Jail where she was booked for 23152(g)VC without incident.
