



18 took to her wall it is called on face booked and posted" If you would like to send something sent it to"
19 and stated an email address. TAG by taking direction sent same information and promo ideas to the
20 stated email address. Then TAG noticed defendant posted on live twitter she would like to help gulf
21 coast animals. Defendant personal problems sent her to jail days later. Stated on her face book acct her
22 mother will be handling her face book acct. TAG went to his work and rebuilt the Grennleafeco.com
22 site while defendant was in jail and worked his peers on face book. A video example was created
23 TAG sister children much needed to show products and was stated to defendants mother in numbers
24 of 300 on two accounts were sent. Stating how faxed contract and use of fed ex could get promo
25 complete with little effort. While the defendant was away her personal problems TAG spent time

1 informing defendant's mother his life and history and showed true concern about defendant. TAG
2 stated at one point don't contact me till defendant's story is out and paid as to keep business separate.
3 A form of communication was set in place by switching defendant's mother to the Coll Mk Sol
4 face book acct. in what is called block of other personal for what could be many reasons on
5 computer. Once defendant was on the business face book. TAG had his sister send a form of contact
6 with initials as to have a witness. It stated that defendant and her mother can promote Greenleafeco.
7 com Earths First Awareness "EFA" Thomas A Green Jr. Art Green and a 15% profits negotiable on any
8 thing I do. Spent some time September 2010. As a result the connection between Coll Mk. Sol. was
10 dissolved. A 3rd face book was created and simple personal interaction was in place with a statement of
11 that was a form communication? YES? TAG assuming so went to a befriending point of defendant was
12 well aware of the status between the two parties and I was held up by the defendant's part. The objective
13 for a global audience was the Gulf Coast animal fund raiser. The time frame of the Defendants
14 verifying in a face book message with "yes I am Lindsay Lohan" the Gulf crisis was at its worst and the
15 EFA aide would be prominent with defendant's willingness to make a deal. The defendant took to
16 playing games as a young female with TAG was serious about creating a new company and fundraiser.
17 Along with verbal communication Defendant took to flashing new pictures of self then a cut off/block
18 in a game form more so then a communication. This now forced TAG to create a 4th face book and
19 replied sorry you have to state who you are now no games communication is difficult and ambiguous
20 on computers. No reply as TAG waited a day and half. Seeing TAG was dealing with an immature

25 and destitute for said defendant's amusements. Said defendant immediately violated her probation that

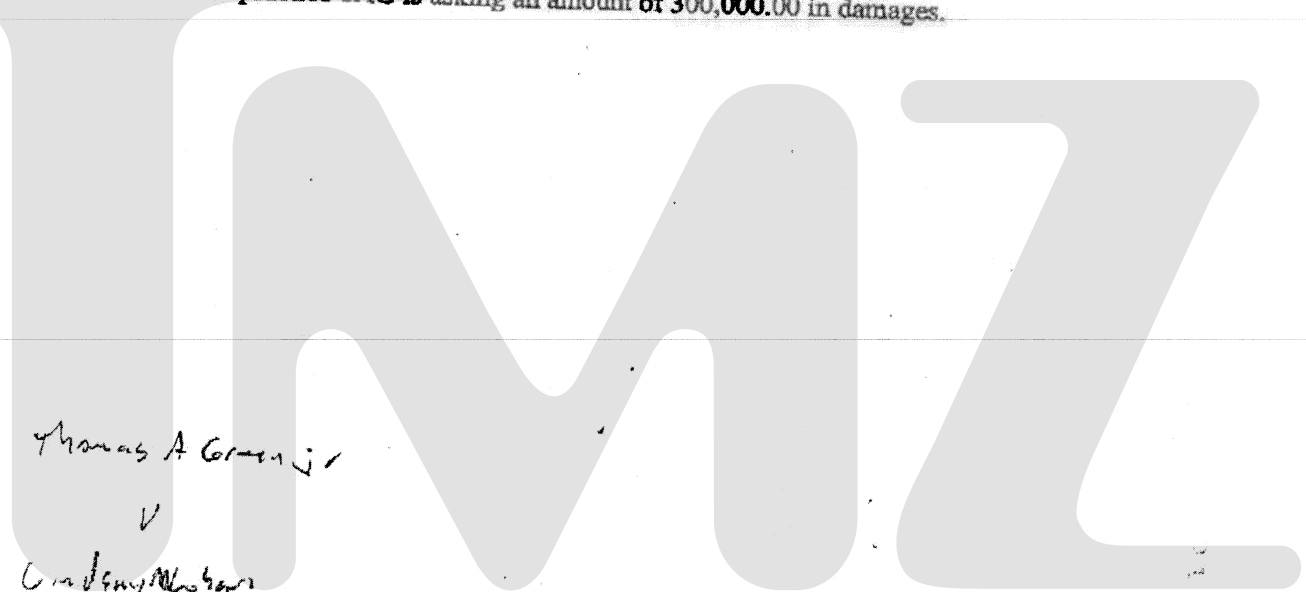
1 she was jailed for the initial contacts. More set backs – knowing the massiveness of what TAG trying

25 is Lindsay Lohan ass hole" as to confirm yes greater things in works. Allegedly. TAG takes to twitter

1 him in the weekend of the Osama assassination. TAG complied thinking he aided some how. Once
2 TAG was released the defendant made it seem she was in trouble and something bad happened in
3 Miami then on to the hard rock person breaking in with his friends to have a party. Mocking TAG of
4 ever doing a dot com with defendant. The defendants home was set like a people magazine picture one
5 green. Two door com three computer Eco friendly site four a m-16 picture pointing in reference to TAG
6 marine corps need to detain to authority. Defendant is one posting on her twitter all these as if a hot
7 poker burned her by hard rock person. Defendant making it seem she in so much mafia trouble help



6 Usoma Bin Ladden thinking this has governmental influences and end result a regrouping on project
7 only with aide of defendant that will be possible. The tensions with his mother and setting in depression
8 situations unclear as to how big Hollywood industry really works. TAGs confrontation with his mother
10 led to police called and TAG leaving town. TAG got on a bus to Jacksonville Florida. Stated live over
11 over in private messages to defendant TAG claims his uncle in Florida leg was broke around the time
12 of the face book contract sent to defendants team and claims an oddness from sister with now
13 confirmation organized crime was in TAG family members house. TAG thinks west coast was involved
14 and the publicist murder was part of TAG connection to defendant. TAG confirms the leg was broke by
15 crime members and sent defendant 100 angry messages as to how vilely angry TAG was at the
16 carelessness of the defendants team as to dragging TAG in on this scale of criminal activity. February
17 2010 TAG messaged defendant on the theft of necklace stating this is an op to set right your life in
18 court and a cover. Defendants response was ambiguous stating what don't you understand cops. TAG
19 made it back to home state where to start his labor. Once TAG returned to Minnesota he set back to his
20 labor and was on his private twitter for anyone to view. TAG states in reading others twitters he could
21 see the status of the mass viewing. TAG set out to command defendant to twitter and stated if defendant
22 acknowledges this is an Osoma Bin Ladden op all civilians in past wrong doing will receive clemency.
22 Defendant responded in the right time. TAG now thinking hell gain money if he continues the op and is
23 effective now has to let go the primary business he set out to complete. TAG went on a dangerous path
24 at request defendant and went off saying hard statement about police judges the authority in country
25 and what they deserve. Ironically enough that attention got his governor to have the state troopers call

1 of industry. TAG states a behind the curtain as the public is not private to all defendants on going TAG
2 claims defendant might be high end prostitute. TAG claims that defendants field is well aware of TAG
3 and TAG has no way to benefit from filed court papers in an exposed media blitz. TAG claims
4 defendant made joke out of TAG and his business. TAG claims unfair business practice and loss of
5 opportunity and ways and means to start a dot. com and fundraiser to create a new distributions and a
6 company in a billion dollar industry. The defendants carelessness and disregard lack of professionalism
7 and self serving with attempts to create more attention for defendants self for unknown personal
8 reasons Civil litigation is a last resort of action to recover loss. Mediation will be considered as to the
10 matter of unfair business practice TAG is asking an amount of 300,000.00 in damages.
