My firm represents Tareq and Michaele Salahi. We understand that tomorrow morning you are shooting your reunion episode. As you may know, independent investigative journalist Diane Dimond, after interviewing over 70 people and reviewing all the documents in the case, recently concluded in her book, *Cirque du Salahi*, that the Salahis did not "crash" the White House dinner, nor the Black Caucus dinner. Having done our own investigation, we reach the same conclusion. It is simply a false statement of fact, and defamatory, to call the Salahis "party crashers," as it suggests they have committed crimes.
