On September 10, 2009 at approximately 0220 hours, I was participating in a license/safety check (Case # 09017013) at I-75/224 (SB) Exit Ramp Stockbridge, GA 30281. I observed a black Cadillac Escalade approach my location driven by Nasir Jones. I stopped the vehicle, I immediately smelled the odor of raw marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. I asked Mr. Jones to pull the vehicle to the side of the roadway, which he did. While speaking with Mr. Jones, I noticed his eyes to be bloodshot and droopy. I asked him to exit the vehicle, which he did. While I spoke with Mr. Jones, Officer Hicks spoke with Jabari Jones (see supplemental). He stated he was returning home from a friends house in Tyrone, GA after his flight home from California. Mr. Jones stated that while at his friends house, he smoked marijuana approximately two hours earlier. I asked him if he would consent to several voluntary field sobriety evaluations, which he verbally agreed.

The first evaluation was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. I observed equal tracking and both pupils to be equal in size. I did not observe any nystagmus.

The next evaluation was the Walk and Turn. I explained and demonstrated the evaluation. Mr. Jones stated he understood my instructions and did not have any questions. During the walking stage, I observed him to raise his arms for balance, miss heel to toe several times, took the Incorrect number of steps (10), turned improperly and stopped on the first nine steps. On the second nine steps, he raised his arms for balance and took the incorrect number of steps (8).

The next evaluation was the One Leg Stand. I explained and demonstrated the evaluation. Mr. Jones stated he understood my instructions and did not have any questions. During the balance and counting stage, I observed noticable body sway and he raised his arms for balance.

The next evaluation was the Romberg Balance. I explained and demonstrated the evaluation. Mr. Jones stated he understood my instructions and did not have any questions. I observed eyelid tremors in both eyes and body tremors. Mr. Jones estimated 21 seconds as 30 seconds.

I observed marked reddening of the conjunctiva in both eyes, Rebound Dilation in both eyes, Mr. Jones had a green tongue with raised taste buds and his pulse was raised to 116 beats per minute.

I placed Mr. Jones under arrest and immediately read him the Georgia Implied Consent Notice for suspects age 21 or over from my DPS-354 (07/01) orange card. Mr. Jones verbally agreed to the state test of his blood. Mr. Jones was transported to the Henry County Jail for the state blood test. I observed Ranford Roper, (Paramedic) draw two vials of blood from the right arm of Mr. Jones. Mr. Roper sealed the two vials of blood in a GBI/DOFS toxicology kit which I later placed into the evidence refrigerator to be sent to the GBI for analysis. Mr. Jones was released to the jail for booking and the vehicle was impounded from the scene by Swanson's Towing and recovery.
