DETAILS:

On September 19, 2010, at approximately 0150 hours, I, Officer K. Ruzicka, P#13806, while operating as marked patrol unit 1L45, I responded to a narcotics call at [REDACTED] Las Vegas, Nevada, [REDACTED]

Upon arrival, I spoke with Security Officer Flanagan, who stated a bathroom attendant came up to him and stated there was a man in the bathroom stall with possibly a man using drugs. The bathroom attendant was identified as Lara, Juan. Spoke with Lara, who stated there was a male in the bathroom stall who was taking a really long time. Lara stated to myself he could see a male in a striped red shirt with a baggy of white powder substance. Once Lara ran into Security Officer Flanagan, they met the male from the bathroom stall exiting the stall. Security Flanagan asked the HMA, later identified by his California driver's license as Peter Hernandez, to give over whatever narcotics he had. That is when Hernandez, with his left hand, pulled out a white powder substance, which was consistent with cocaine, from his left-front jeans pocket. That is when Flanagan took him to the holding cell.

I asked Hernandez, "What's going on? Why am I here today?" to which Hernandez stated, "Can I speak to you honestly, sir?" Hernandez admitted he did a foolish thing and has never used drugs before.

Hernandez was placed under arrest as the white powder substance came back positive for cocaine. Hernandez was transported to Clark County Detention Center, where he was booked accordingly.
