FELONY COMPLAINT

The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about January 17, 2016, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of POSSESSION FOR SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, in violation of HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 11378, a Felony, was committed by ORLANDO BROWN, who did unlawfully possess for purpose of sale a controlled substance, to wit, methamphetamine.

"NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 11590. Failure to do so is a crime pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 11594."

COUNT 2

On or about January 17, 2016, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of BRINGING CONTRABAND INTO THE JAIL, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 4573(a), a Felony, was committed by ORLANDO BROWN, who did unlawfully, and knowingly bring and send into and assist in bringing into and sending into Torrance Police Department Jail, a controlled substance and a device, contrivance, instrument, and paraphernalia intended to be used for injecting and consuming a controlled substance.

COUNT 3

On or about January 17, 2016, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of BATTERY, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 243(e)(1), a Misdemeanor, was committed by ORLANDO BROWN, who did willfully and unlawfully use force and violence upon the person of OMENA ALEX MARKARIAN, a person dating relationship.

COUNT 4

On or about January 17, 2016, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of RESISTING, DELAYING OR OBSTRUCTING A PUBLIC OFFICER, PEACE OFFICER OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 148(a)(1), a Misdemeanor, was committed by ORLANDO BROWN, who willfully resisted, delayed, and/or obstructed Officer Such, a peace officer , in the discharge or attempted discharge of a duty of his office or employment.

* * * * *

NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require the defendant to provide DNA samples and print impressions pursuant to Penal Code sections 296 and 296.1. Willful refusal to provide the samples and impressions is a crime.

NOTICE: The People of the State of California intend to present evidence and seek jury findings regarding all applicable circumstances in aggravation, pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(b) and *Cunningham v. California* (2007) 549 U.S. 270.

NOTICE: A Suspected Child Abuse Report (SCAR) may have been generated within the meaning of Penal Code §§ 11166 and 11168 involving the charges alleged in this complaint. Dissemination of a SCAR is limited by Penal Code §§ 11167 and 11167.5 and a court order is required for full disclosure of the contents of a SCAR

NOTICE: Any allegation making a defendant ineligible to serve a state prison sentence in the county jail shall not be subject to dismissal pursuant to Penal Code § 1385.
