The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about January 17, 2016, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of POSSESSION FOR SALE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, in violation of HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 11378, a Felony, was committed by ORLANDO BROWN, who did unlawfully possess for purpose of sale a controlled substance, to wit, methamphetamine.

On or about January 17, 2016, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of RESISTING, DELAYING OR OBSTRUCTING A PUBLIC OFFICER, PEACE OFFICER OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 148(a)(1), a Misdemeanor, was committed by ORLANDO BROWN, who willfully resisted, delayed, and/or obstructed Officer Such, a peace officer, in the discharge or attempted discharge of a duty of his office or employment.
