

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE :

Officers responded to a medical call involving an adult male who had fallen and hit his head. It was reported while en route that the patient was unconscious and breathing was unknown.

I arrived first on-scene and entered the residence through the garage door on the East side of the residence. The complainant Ms. Shannon Price was at the door and directed me to where the patient Mr. Gary Coleman was located. Ms. Price then went upstairs and spoke over the hand rail as to avoid having to see the blood on the floor.

I entered the kitchen area and found Mr. Coleman sitting back on his legs with his arms in front of him and hands on the floor. Mr. Coleman had a towel over the back of his head and was wearing . . . There was a second towel on the floor near his hands. Also on the floor was a small pool of blood with little smearing next to it.

. . . calling him by name and advising him that I was a police officer that we were there to assist him until medical personnel arrived. I asked Mr. Coleman if he could tell me what had happened. He looked at me and said that he did not remember. I asked him where he was on the floor of the kitchen and he said he did not remember.

I removed the towel from Mr. Coleman's head and observed . . . inches long . . . however, I applied sterile gauzes and . . . the wound . . . medical personnel arrived to . . .

While waiting for medical personnel to arrive, I observed that Mr. Coleman was . . . would act like . . . he would then . . . Coleman could . . . medical personnel . . . the kitchen and . . . was able to walk out and into the garage with some assistance.

While waiting for medical personnel to arrive, and again after they left for patient transport, I looked around the kitchen area for any areas of possible impact besides the tile floor. I could not locate any other blood in the kitchen area or other objects where Mr. Coleman may have otherwise fallen and hit his head. There was nothing of suspicion to note in the kitchen area of the home.

After looking over kitchen Officer Stika and I went upstairs to speak with Ms. Price. She was lying in her bed and asking about Mr. Coleman's condition. She advised that he had just had . . . earlier that morning and she thought . . .

The two had been in the bed watching television when she asked Coleman if he would go downstairs and prepare her some food. He agreed and went downstairs. A short time later Price heard a loud thud as if Coleman had dropped something heavy or as if he may have fallen himself. Price went to check on Coleman when he did not respond to her calls and found him laying on the kitchen floor with blood around his head. She then called 911 for medical assistance.

Officers cleared the residence after speaking with Ms. Price. No further action was necessary at that time.
