Please accept this correspondence as a formal offer to completely resolve and settle all active disputes, claims, and pending litigation between myself, Scott Thompson, Creative Artists Agency, LLC, Steve Levine, and Chad Fitzgerald.

In the interest of avoiding the ongoing expense, time, and mutual burdens of litigation, I am proposing a global settlement under the following structural terms:

1. **Settlement Amount:** A total global resolution payment of **\$2,000,000.00**.
2. **Global Releases:** Execution of full, mutual, and complete releases of all claims that have been or could have been brought between the parties.
3. **Dismissal with Prejudice:** Prompt dismissal of Case No. CACE26012670 and Case No. CACE26012570 with prejudice, with each party bearing their own respective attorneys' fees and costs. Withdraw of Signature Resolution proceedings for which I will also dismiss.
4. **Mutual Confidentiality:** A standard, comprehensive mutual non-disclosure and non-disparagement agreement governing the terms of the settlement and the underlying subject matter.

This compromise offer is made without any admission of liability or fault by any party, solely to achieve a complete and final resolution.

This offer shall remain open for your client's consideration until Wednesday **September 16, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time**, at which point it will be automatically withdrawn if not accepted in writing.
