Dear Judge Dabney,

I am pleased to report that Ms. Lohan has successfully completed her court-ordered course of treatment at Cliffside Malibu Treatment Center. However, as our progress report of last Friday, 7/26/2013, indicates, we feel it is critical that Ms. Lohan have court ordered therapy, specifically three fifty-minute sessions a week for the next eighteen months. This should be done face to face while she is in town, and via skype or phone session if she is out of town. These sessions should be verified by a monthly update to the court from the therapist solely for the purpose of confirming Ms. Lohan's attendance. Our entire clinical team is in unanimous agreement that if these sessions are not required by the court and attendance verified once a month to ensure accountability, it is a set up for almost certain failure.

I thank you for the trust and confidence you, Mr. White, Mr. Hart, and Mrs. Holley placed in Cliffside Malibu. We couldn't be happier with the progress Ms. Lohan has made in building a solid foundation from which to continue the excellent work she has begun here at Cliffside Malibu.
