1 TO DATE, THE DEFENDANT HAS NOT PROVIDED PROOF TO THE PROBATION  
2 OFFICER THAT SHE HAS COMPLIED WITH ANY OF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS.  
3 THE PROBATION OFFICER ATTEMPTED TO CONTACT THE DEFENDANT THROUGH HER  
4 ASSISTANT, AS THERE IS SOME TYPE OF BLOCK ON THE DEFENDANT'S HOME  
5 TELEPHONE. MESSAGES WERE LEFT WITH THE ASSISTANT ON JULY 12TH,  
6 13TH, AND 14TH, ASKING HER TO HAVE THE DEFENDANT CONTACT THE  
7 PROBATION OFFICER, TO NO AVAIL. *Prob now states D phoned 3 times on 6/15 & left message* ✓  
8 ON JUNE 2, 2011, THE DEFENDANT WAS REFERRED TO AM/PM CONVENIENT WEST  
9 LOS ANGELES SCHOOL FOR THEFT COUNSELING. SHE HAS NOT PROVIDED PROOF  
10 THAT SHE HAS ENROLLED IN COUNSELING WITH THIS AGENCY. *D was ordered to provide proof to court, not prob.*  
11 THE PROBATION OFFICER CONTACTED DR. SAJAY, THE DEFENDANT'S PREVIOUS  
12 THERAPIST, ON OR ABOUT JUNE 6, 2011. HE INDICATED THE DEFENDANT  
13 SHOULD HAVE INSURANCE THROUGH THE SCREEN ACTORS GUILD, AND SHE COULD  
14 PICK A THERAPIST FROM THE INSURANCE LISTING, AND FOLLOW THROUGH WITH  
15 THE SESSIONS.  
16 THE DEFENDANT WAS ALSO ORDERED TO COMPLETE 480 HOURS OF COMMUNITY  
17 SERVICE. THE DEFENDANT'S ATTORNEY INDICATES THAT THE DEFENDANT HAS  
18 COMPLETED SOME COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS, BUT THE DEFENDANT HAS NOT  
19 PROVIDED VERIFICATION. *D was ordered to provide proof to court on 7/21 - not to probation*

20 REMARKS:

21 IT APPEARS THAT THE DEFENDANT IS NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH PROBATION.  
22 IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT SHE BE FOUND IN VIOLATION OF PROBATION; AND  
23 THAT SHE BE CONTINUED ON FORMAL PROBATION UNTIL SHE ENROLLS IN
