On or about October 9, 2009, SA Brian Smith received an anonymous call from cell phone number [REDACTED]. The caller stated that we should investigate James Rosemond a.k.a. "Jimmy Henchman" in regards to the Lowell Fletcher a.k.a. "Lodi Mack" homicide.

After further investigation it was discovered that the phone used to place the anonymous tip was connected to Curtis "50 Cent" Jackson.

On October 12, 2009, SAs Brian Smith and David Torres arrived at the home of Jackson located at [REDACTED], Farmington, Connecticut. Jackson confirmed that he was the person who placed the anonymous call and that he was in fear of his life following the death of Lowell "Lodi Mack" Fletcher.

When asked what he believed the motive for "Henchman" to murder "Lodi" he stated that he believed "Lodi" was killed for the assault on "Henchman's" 14 year old son, "Lodi" and various band members from the G-Unit group had participated in.

Jackson stated that he would cooperate with the investigation and would be willing to provide any information he may have in connection to shootings involving "Jimmy Henchman".

Jackson disclosed that he was shot in the past and the persons who attempted to kill him had been hired by Irving Lorenzo a.k.a. "Irv Gotti" and Kenneth McGriff a.k.a. "Supreme", further asserting the fear for his life.
