You Cannot Have Guns or Firearms

You cannot own, have, possess, buy or try to buy, receive or try to receive, or otherwise get a gun while this Order is in effect. If you do, you can go to jail and pay a \$1,000 fine. You must sell to a licensed gun dealer or turn in to police any guns or firearms that you have or control in accordance with item **8** above. The court will require you to prove that you did so. If you do not obey this Order, you can be charged with a crime.

Instructions for Law Enforcement

Stone v. Gooden

[Petitioner's Additional Factual Summary and Memorandum of Points and Authorities In Support of Her Petition/Application for Orders Prohibiting Harassment]

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FACTUAL SUMMARY & BACKGROUND

1. Petitioner Sharon Stone ("Ms. Stone" and/or "Petitioner") respectfully submits this factual summary and memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support of her Petition and Request for Orders Prohibiting Harassment against Respondent Bradley Gooden a/k/a Bobby Joe Clinton ("Gooden" and/or "Respondent").

2. Although Ms. Stone is a well-known theatrical motion picture actor, she is entitled, like any citizen, to be free of intrusion, harassment and stalking from an obsessed and mentally unstable delusional person. Petitioner does not personally know nor have any relationship with Gooden, has never spoken with him nor initiated personal contact of any type with him, nor does she desire any interaction or communication with him what-so-ever. See accompanying Declaration of Sharon Stone ("Stone Decl.," ¶4. Despite these facts, Gooden, a mentally ill individual, has sought to have personal contact with Petitioner and insert himself into Petitioner's personal and private life. (Id., ¶4); and See accompanying Declaration of LAPD Threat Management Unit Detective and Department Head, Jeff Dunn ("Dunn Decl."), ¶6. Since Gooden is understood to be a delusional and paranoid schizophrenic, which has caused and/or exasperates the situation, the need for an order against harassment is all the more important as a tool for law enforcement to protect Petitioner from Gooden's unwanted interaction (Dunn Decl., ¶¶11-12).

3. Gooden's conduct poses a credible threat of violence and imminent danger to Petitioner. (Stone Decl., ¶¶5-6; Dunn Decl., ¶11). Gooden has committed on-going acts of stalking and harassment against Petitioner, in a knowing and willful course of conduct directed at her which has and is seriously alarming, annoying and/or harassing her, and that serves no legitimate purpose, as further summarized herein. (Stone Decl., ¶6).

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1 4. Gooden's bizarre, intrusive, harassing and stalking conduct includes his recently
2 traveling cross-country by bus in his delusional mission to locate Petitioner and/or her property
3 and take residence at her hoouse, which he knew was owned by Petitioner but believes was given
4 to him. (Dunn Decl., ¶¶6, 8-9)

5 5. On February 11, 2011, LAPD Officers were dispatched, pursuant to a
6 prowler/trespass report, to a property and residence owned by Petitioner. (Stone Decl., ¶4; Dunn
7 Decl., ¶6). Upon the Officers' arrival, they discovered a man, later identified as Mr. Gooden,
8 at Petitioner's property and inside the residence. Gooden had trespassed at the property owned
9 by Petitioner, and had broken into the house with the intention of residing in Petitioner's house.
10 (Dunn Decl., ¶¶5-6). After he was discovered laying-in-wait inside the house by LAPD Officers,
11 and upon questioning as to his presence, Gooden stated that he lived at the property, that it was
12 his house, and identified himself by stating "I am Bobby Joe Clinton, son of Hillary Clinton."
13 Gooden was at that time detained; and he produced an Ohio driver's license that listed his true
14 name, Bradly Gooden. Gooden than made various additional disorganized and irrational
15 delusional statements to the LADP Officers, including that "his mother [former First Lady and
16 Secretary of State] Hillary Clinton bought him the house [from Sharon Stone] as a present," that
17 it is "now my [his] house" and that "I [he] live here [at that house]." Gooden also admitted
18 directly to LAPD Officers that he recently traveled by bus cross-country, from Ohio to Los
19 Angeles, California, specifically to locate and go to Petitionr's house, and, upon arrival in Los
20 Angeles, took a taxi-cab from the bus station directly to Petitioner's property with intention to live
21 in her house. (Id., ¶¶5-8).

22 6. Due to his unlawful entry into Petitioner's house and his exhibiting signs of sever
23 mental illness, Gooden was than taken into custody. Gooden was also interviewed and evaluated
24 by county S.M.A.R.T. team mental health professionals working with the LAPD TMU. Gooden
25 was at that time placed on a temporary 5150 psychological mental evaluation hold. Gooden has
26 been diagnosed as an apparent schizophrenic, who exhibits classic symptoms of delusional
27 schizophrenia. In interviews with LAPD, mental health personnel, and with law enforcement
28 trained with expertise in the area of threat assessment of stalkers and threat situations, Gooden has

1 delusionally stated and confirmed that he believes that, at age 2, he "wrote the script" of the
2 current Oscar nominated film "King's Speech," and that he is an FBI agent. Gooden has further
3 delusionally stated that he is the son of former First Lady and Secretary of State Hillary Clinton
4 and that his "mother" Hillary Clinton bought him Sharon Stone's house as a present and that he
5 now lives at Petitioner's house. (Dunn Decl., ¶¶5-9). The 5150 psych hold was placed and than
6 extended upon a determination by mental health professionals that Gooden posed an imminent
7 danger to himself and/or others, including potentially to Petitioner and/or her children, and based
8 on his delusions and his abnormal and delusional fixation on Petitioner and/or her property. (Dunn
9 Decl., ¶¶7, 10). However, although it was understood that he was not scheduled to be released
10 prior to at least February 28, 2011, Gooden was released (by a temporary doctor filling-in and
11 working on the holiday) on February 21, 2011 and assigned to the care of a halfway house board
12 and care facility. (Id., ¶10).

13 7. During Gooden's 5150 psychological mental evaluation hold, during one of more
14 times while interviewed by the S.M.A.R.T. team working with the LAPD TMU, Gooden
15 continued to maintain that the house (Petitioner's house) was a present from his "mother" Hillary
16 Clinton, and that it was his home, where he delusionally believes he lives. (Dunn Decl., ¶9).
17 Gooden has exhibited an abnormal and delusional, and ultimately harassing, fixation on Petitioner
18 and/or her property. Based on his delusional belief that Petitioner's house was given to him as
19 a present from Hillary Clinton, Gooden appears determined to return to, seek to gain entry into,
20 and seek to take residence in Petitioner's house.

21 8. As evidenced by Gooden's fixation on and obsession with Petitioner and/or her
22 house, and Gooden's compulsive stalking of Petitioner, including his travel cross-country to locate
23 and gain access to her house, thereafter his breaking into Petitioner's house and laying-in-wait in
24 the house for Petitioner, and his various delusional and irrational statements, the nature of
25 Gooden's conduct is alarming and his motivation and obsession are ominous, intrusive and
26 extremely threatening.

28 ///

1 9. As set forth in this Petition/Application and the accompanying Declaration of
2 Sharon Stone ("Stone Decl.") and Declaration of LAPD Threat Management Unit Detective and
3 Department Head, Jeff Dunn ("Dunn Decl."), as well as the statements and admissions of Gooden
4 himself, Gooden has engaged in wrongful acts of harassment, stalking and implied threats of
5 violence against Petitioner (by breaking into and laying-in-wait in Petitioner's home), and made
6 express statements indicating that unless restrained the conduct is very likely not only to continue,
7 but also to escalate and cause further harassment, including potentially severe physical harm.

8 10. Gooden has displayed a compulsive and unrelenting desire to make contact with
9 Petitioner and to move-in to her house in particular, and traveled cross-country to locate and gain
10 access into Petitioner's property and house. Gooden is clearly a person obsessed with Petitioner
11 and being in her house, and now that he has traveled cross-country to the location of Petitioner's
12 house, Gooden admittedly will not stop stalking and attempting to insert himself into her personal
13 and private life and gain access to her house until, or unless, ordered by a court of law -- in order
14 to provide a necessary tool for law enforcement to protect Petitioner. (Dunn Decl., ¶¶6-9, 11).

15 11. Based on all of these facts it is clear that unless restrained by court order for the
16 maximum period, and pending hearing on this Petition, Gooden's harassing and stalking conduct
17 will continue, and escalate, and Petitioner's safety and welfare of would be placed in jeopardy.

19 **APPLICATION FOR AN OSC RE TRO AND FOR INJUNCTION SHOULD BE**
20 **GRANTED TO RESTRAIN GOODEN FROM FURTHER HARASSING CONDUCT**

21 12. Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure Section 527.6, a person who has suffered
22 harassment, such as by stalking, may seek a restraining order and an injunction prohibiting
23 harassment. Code Civ. Proc. § 527.6(a). It provides, in pertinent part:

24 “(a) A person who has suffered harassment as defined in subdivision (b) may seek
25 a temporary restraining order and an injunction prohibiting harassment as provided
in this section.

26 “(b) For the purposes of this section, “harassment” is unlawful violence, a credible
27 threat of violence, or a knowing and willful course of conduct directed at a
28 specific person that seriously alarms, annoys, or harasses the person, and that
serves no legitimate purpose. The course of conduct must be such as would cause
a reasonable person to suffer substantial emotional distress, and must actually cause
substantial emotional distress to the plaintiff.”

1 ***

2 “(1) ‘Unlawful violence’ is any assault or battery, or stalking as prohibited in
3 Section 646.9 of the Penal Code, but shall not include lawful acts of self-defense
4 or defense of others.

5 (2) ‘Credible threat of violence’ is a knowing and willful statement or course of
6 conduct that would place a reasonable person in fear for his or her safety, or the
7 safety of his or her immediate family, and that serves no legitimate purpose.

8 (3) ‘Course of conduct’ is a pattern of conduct composed of a series of acts over
9 a period of time, however short, evidencing a continuity of purpose, including
10 following or stalking an individual, making harassing telephone calls to an
11 individual, or sending harassing correspondence to an individual by any means,
12 including, but not limited to, the use of public or private mails, interoffice mail,
13 fax, or computer e-mail. Constitutionally protected activity is not included within
14 the meaning of “course of conduct.”

15 Code Civ. Proc. § 527.6 (emphasis added).

16 13. Gooden’s conduct directed at Petitioner constitutes harassment and unlawful threat
17 of violence by stalking and a willful course of conduct directed against Petitioner, which has
18 seriously alarmed, annoyed and harassed her and which serves no legitimate purpose. CCP §
19 527.6(b). (Stone Decl., ¶6).

20 14. It is clear from Gooden’s bizarre and irrational and delusional conduct and
21 statements, and his menacing and harassing conduct, that unless restrained by court order for the
22 maximum period and pending hearing on this Petition, Gooden’s harassing, threatening and
23 stalking conduct will continue and likely increase and maybe worsen. As a result of Gooden’s
24 stalking and harassing behavior, including his recent actions of showing-up at property and a home
25 owned by Petitioner in order to attempt to move-in and reside at that location, and trying to insert
26 himself into her private life, Petitioner has become seriously alarmed and has real and reasonable
27 fears for her safety, and, most importantly, that of her minor children, as well as that of her
28 friends, representatives and those around her. (Stone Decl., ¶¶6-7).

15 15. The injunctive relief sought herein should be granted for a period of three (3) years.
16 Such a period is authorized by Code of Civil Procedure § 527.6(d). The three (3) year period is
17 necessary in order to protect Petitioner from the Gooden’s obsession and fixation which has
18 manifested into harassing, unprivileged and threatening conduct.

DECLARATION OF SHARON STONE

I, SHARON STONE, declare as follows:

1. The facts stated herein are stated of my own personal knowledge and, if called and sworn as a witness, I could and would testify competently thereto.

2. I am a professional actress. I am the petitioner in the captioned action.

3. This declaration is submitted in support of the Request for an Order to Stop Harassment against a Bradly Gooden, whom I understand calls himself Bobby Joe Clinton, and supplements my signed submission of the application form titled "Request for Orders to Stop Harassment", and my statements and the facts contained in the incorporated Attachment "A" thereto (collectively, the "Request for Orders to Stop Harassment").

4. As set forth in the Request for Orders to Stop Harassment, I do not personally know nor have any relationship with Bradly Gooden a/k/a Bobby Joe Clinton, nor do I desire any interaction or communication with him what-so-ever. Despite these facts, Mr. Gooden has aggressively sought to have personal contact with me and insert himself into my life, including trespassing on my property and breaking into my house.

5. I have been informed and am aware that Mr. Gooden exhibits various signs of extreme mental illness. I have been further informed and am aware that Mr. Gooden is under various extreme delusional beliefs, including the delusional beliefs that he is a government agent, the screen writer of "King's Speech," and the son of Hilary Clinton. I have been further informed and am aware that Mr. Gooden has stated that he believes his mother Hilary Clinton purchased my home from me as a present for him. I have been further informed and am aware that Mr. Gooden recently traveled across the country, to Los Angeles, California, to locate me and my home. I am aware that Mr. Gooden was discovered while inside of the house on my property, and taken into custody by law enforcement. I understand that, despite Mr. Gooden being informed by law enforcement and mental health workers that his beliefs are delusional and that he is to cease any attempts to gain access to me or my property, he has reaffirmed his continued desire to and stated that he will continue to seek to go to and gain access my property and my house.



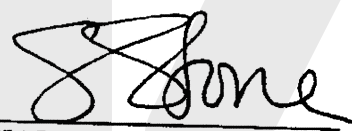
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6. Due to what I understand to be Mr. Gooden's delusional compulsion and harassing, stalking and what I interpret as threatening conduct by his unauthorized entry into my property, I have been subjected to a course of conduct which has and is seriously alarming, annoying and harassing me. Mr. Gooden's on-going, physical and harassing conduct are extremely distressing. I am in fear from Mr. Gooden for my personal safety, and that of those around me, including especially my children and family, as well as my friends and employees.

7. As set forth in my declaration by submission of my Request for Orders to Stop Harassment, the Attachment "A" thereto, and related pleadings and exhibits, I respectfully request that the Court make an order prohibiting and restraining Bradly Gooden from coming near me, my family, my residences, my workplaces, my children's schools and activity locations, or wherever we are, and prohibit any other type of harassment and any attempted communications, whether directly or indirectly.

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DECLARATION OF DETECTIVE JEFF DUNN

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3 I, JEFF DUNN, LAPD Detective, declare as follows:

4 1. The facts stated herein are stated of my own personal knowledge and, if called and
5 sworn as a witness, I could and would testify competently thereto.

6 2. I am over 18 years of age. I am a over twenty-year veteran and a detective with
7 the Los Angeles Police Department ("LAPD"), and I am a detective currently assigned to and am
8 the head of the LAPD's Threat Management Unit ("LAPD TMU"). My current responsibilities
9 involve overseeing all cases and matters with the LAPD TMU, and investigating stalking cases
10 wherein an individual demonstrates an abnormal fixation on another person(s) and/or generates
11 a long term pattern of harassment.

12 3. The LAPD TMU, established in 1990, was the first law enforcement division in
13 the country created to specialize in and combat stalking. The LAPD TMU, which serves the
14 famous, infamous and not-famous alike, is also responsible for investigating all threats directed
15 to the city's elected officials and aggravated stalking cases on a citywide basis; maintaining liaison
16 with identified entertainment industry studios within the city; investigating workplace violence
17 involving City entities and employees; and serving as a standing resource for the City's Threat
18 Assessment Team. The LAPD TMU handles approximately 250 cases a year; with celebrity
19 stalkers accounting for at least 10 percent of the LAPD TMU annual caseload.

20 4. As a detective, member of and the head of the LAPD TMU, I am an expert in the
21 area of threat assessment of stalkers and threat situations, including celebrity stalkers. In
22 furtherance of my knowledge in this area, I and the entire LAPD TMU actively participate in The
23 Association of Threat Assessment Professionals (ATAP), a non-profit organization whose
24 objective is to learn more about how best to protect victims of stalking, harassment and threat
25 situations. The ATAP is a diverse association comprised of professionals such as law enforcement
26 officers, prosecutors, mental health professionals, and corporate security experts. Its mission is
27 to share and facilitate the experiences and techniques of professionals in the field of threat
28 assessment and/or threat management, including at scheduled conferences, to, among other things,

1 increase our expertise in assessing how best to protect victims of stalking, harassment and threat
2 situations.

3 5. I am the lead detective assigned to the criminal matter and investigation with regard
4 to a male adult individual by the name of Bradly Gooden, and calling himself Bobby Joe Clinton,
5 and his apparent abnormal fixation on Sharon Stone and her property, and his trespasses and
6 unauthorized entry into a house owned by Ms. Stone. During the course of my investigation and
7 preparation of a police file and threat evaluation with regard to Mr. Gooden, I have personally
8 reviewed the police, incident and evaluation reports with regard to Mr. Gooden's activities
9 directed at Ms. Stone and her property, and with regard to his mental state, and have obtained and
10 have personal knowledge and/or information as follows.

11 **Gooden's Trespass and Entry into Ms. Stone's House; and Delusional Statements**

12 6. On February 11, 2011, LAPD Officers were dispatched, pursuant to a
13 prowler/trespass report, to a property and residence owned by Ms. Stone. Upon the Officers'
14 arrival, they discovered a man, later identified as Mr. Gooden, at Ms. Stone's property and inside
15 the residence. Upon questioning as to his presence, Mr. Gooden stated that he lived at the
16 property, that it was his house, and identified himself by stating "I am Bobby Joe Clinton, son of
17 Hillary Clinton." Mr. Gooden was at that time detained; and he produced an Ohio driver's license
18 that listed his true name Bradly Gooden. Mr. Gooden made additional disorganized and irrational
19 apparent delusional statements to the LADP Officers, including that his mother Hillary Clinton
20 bought him the house from Sharon Stone as a present, that he lives at that house, that at age 2 he
21 wrote the script of the current Oscar nominated film "King's Speech," and that he is an FBI agent.
22 Mr. Gooden has admitted directly to LAPD Officers that he recently traveled by bus cross-
23 country, from Ohio to Los Angeles, California, specifically to locate and go to Ms. Stone's house,
24 and, upon arrival in Los Angeles, took a taxi-cab from the bus station directly to Ms. Stone's
25 property with intention to live in Ms. Stone's house.

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1 **5150 Hold and Current Delusional Schizophrenia and/or Mental Illness**

2 7. After Mr. Gooden was discovered in a residence owned by Ms. Stone and detained,
3 and due to his exhibiting signs of sever mental illness, Mr. Gooden was also interviewed and
4 evaluated by county S.M.A.R.T. team mental health professionals working with the LAPD TMU.
5 Mr. Gooden was placed on a temporary 5150 psychological mental evaluation hold, which was/is
6 based on an evaluation that the subject could pose a danger to himself or others, and based on his
7 delusions and abnormal fixation on Ms. Stone and/or her property.

8 **Current Delusional Schizophrenia and/or Mental Illness**

9 8. Through interview of Mr. Gooden by LAPD Officers and by county mental health
10 professionals in the course of my investigation, and through my review of police records and
11 reports, I am informed and believe that Mr. Gooden suffers from sever mental illnesses, including
12 possibly from delusional schizophrenia or other delusional psychotic illness. I am aware that Mr.
13 Mr. Gooden has made delusional statements that he believes he is the son of former First Lady
14 and Secretary of State Hilary Clinton, that he is an FBI agent, and that Ms. Stone's house was
15 given to him as a present and that it is his house to live in. Mr. Gooden displays a delusional
16 fixation on Ms. Stone and/or her house.

17 9. During Mr. Gooden's 5150 psychological mental evaluation hold, while interviewed
18 by the S.M.A.R.T. team working with my LAPD TMU, Gooden continued to maintain that the
19 house (Ms. Stone's house) was his home and that it was a present from his "mother" Hillary
20 Clinton.

21 10. Although Mr. Gooden has been detained on a 5150 psychological mental evaluation
22 hold since the time of discovery of his trespass into Ms. Stone's residence on or about Friday,
23 February 11, 2011, I am informed and understand that his hold temporary period ended and he
24 was released on February 21, 2011 and assigned to the care of a halfway house board and care
25 facility.

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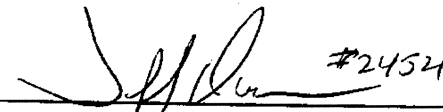
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11. During my hundreds of TMU investigations, I have evaluated and interviewed numerous suspects in regards to their methods of operation, as well as numerous victims, in terms of the process of mental anguish they have endured, and am I am a trained expert in stalking threat assessment. It is my professional opinion that Mr. Gooden has a delusional and abnormal fixation on Ms. Stone and her property, and that he poses a real security concern, credible threat of violence, and imminent danger to the health and welfare of Ms. Stone and, potentially, her minor children. My opinion and evaluation is based on my experience as an over twenty-year veteran and detective with the LAPD, and member of the LAPD TMU, participation in Threat Management Conferences and threat assessment education and expertise, and, among other things, my evaluation of Mr. Gooden's behaviour, my knowledge of the facts related to Mr. Gooden's current obsessive attention towards Ms. Stone and her property, my evaluation of information and case files provided by law enforcement and mental health professionals who have been involved in this matter involving Mr. Gooden, and my review of the facts contained in the Application for TRO and Injunction Against Harassment in the matter *Stone v. Gooden*.

12. It is my professional opinion that it is imperative as a tool for law enforcement to help protect Ms. Stone and her family from Mr. Gooden and his delusional fixation and harassment, that a civil TRO and an Injunction Against Harassment be issued against Mr. Gooden.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct.

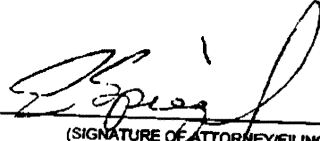
