11. Description of Incident (Date: 9/1/2011 Time 11:50 AM Staff become aware of incident) On August 31, 2011 Inmate Clifford J. Harris reg. no. 59458-019, arrived at Dismas Charities Atlanta Residential Reentry Center via motor coach bus from FCC Forest City, Arkansas. On August 31, 2011, the Atlanta CCM, instructed me to page Inmate Harris to my office for a conference call. The individuals present during the conference call were Ronald James CCM via teleconference, on site Reginald Brown Assistant Director, Patricia Simpson Counselor, and Inmate Clifford J. Harris Jr. The CCM introduced himself and began asking inmate Harris questions regarding his mode of transportation and individuals present on the bus with him. When questioned regarding the individuals on the bus with him during his travel from FCC Forest City, Arkansas, to Dismas Charities Atlanta Residential Reentry Center, he stated, his wife, manager and two producers with VH1 were on the bus. Such people were not authorized to travel with him in the conditions of furlough. He further indicated he was discussing a new reality series and a book with these individuals, but made a point of indicating it was not an interview. Inmate Harris had not been authorized to be in contact or be in the presence of his manager or others, except his wife, during his travel. Additionally, his actions of discussing a new reality series and book with VH1 producers was considered to be conducting a business as he was conducting potential business ventures between him and VH1. The telephone conference ended at approximately 12:00 PM (NOON). Inmate Harris was released back to his living quarters.
