**REASON FOR HEARING:**

THIS MATTER WAS LAST BEFORE THE COURT ON SEPTEMBER 17, 2012, AND ON THE COURT'S MOTION THE MATTER WAS CONTINUED FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT REGARDING THE PROBATIONER'S COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRESS AND VERIFICATION OF PROBATIONER'S ADDRESS TO DETERMINE IF SUPERVISION BY INTERSTATE COMACT IS WARRANTED.

**RECORD BUREAU CLEARANCE:**

THE PROBATIONER'S CASE IS REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE BUREAU OF CRIMINAL IDENTIFICATION AND INVESTIGATION (CII). A RECORDS CHECK COMPLETED ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2012, VIA CII, THE CONSOLIDATED CRIMINAL HISTORY REPORTING SYSTEM (CCHRS), TRIAL COURT INFORMATION SYSTEM (TCIS), DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE (STATE OF VIRGINIA AND CALIFORNIA) AND FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION (FBI) REVEALED NO DEPARTMENTAL ACTION FROM THE AFOREMENTIONED AGENCIES.

2 **REPORT:**

3 THE PROBATIONER IS CURRENTLY BEING SUPERVISED IN THE STATE OF  
4 VIRGINIA VIA INTERSTATE COMPACT. THE INTERSTATE COMPACT OFFICER IN THE STATE OF  
5 CALIFORNIA RECEIVED DOCUMENTATION DATED AUGUST 15, 2012, FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF  
6 VIRGINIA, INDICATING WITHIN THE LAST TWO MONTHS THERE HAVE BEEN TWO INCIDENTS  
7 INVOLVING THE PROBATIONER.

8 ON JUNE 18, 2012, THE PROBATIONER TESTED POSITIVE FOR MARIJUANA, AND  
9 ON JULY 22, 2012, HE FAILED TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING  
10 TRAVELING OUTSIDE OF THE STATE OF VIRGINIA. THE DOCUMENT STATED THE PROBATIONER  
11 FAILED TO OBTAIN A TRAVEL PERMIT AND FAILED TO REPORT TO THE PROBATION DEPARTMENT  
12 ONCE HE RETURNED TO VIRGINIA. THE PROBATIONER PROVIDED A CARD FROM ACUPUNCTURIST  
13 KETINO KARAKALIDI, AUTHORIZING THE MEDICAL USE OF MARIJUANA. THE COMMONWEALTH OF  
14 VIRGINIA HAS NO LAWS PERMITTING THE USE OF MARIJUANA IN ANY FORM.

15 ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2012, THE INTERSTATE COMPACT OFFICER IN THE STATE OF  
16 CALIFORNIA RECEIVED ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION FROM THE STATE OF VIRGINIA INDICATING  
17 THE PROBATIONER COMPLETED FOURTEEN HUNDRED AND TWO HOURS (1402) OF COMMUNITY  
18 SERVICE. PROBATION OFFICER HAS ATTACHED COPIES OF DOCUMENTATION RECEIVED FROM THE  
19 STATE OF VIRGINIA FOR THE COURT'S REVIEW.

20 IN ADDITION THE DOCUMENT FROM VIRGINIA INDICATES THE PROBATIONER  
21 IS FAMILIAR WITH THE PROCEDURES REGARDING TRAVELING GIVEN HIS SCHEDULE AND THE  
22 PROBATIONER IS IN VIOLATION OF PROBATION.

23 ON SEPTEMBER 19, 2012 THE UNDERSIGNED RECEIVED CORRESPONDENCE  
24 FROM BRYAN T. NORWOOD; CHIEF OF POLICE (RICHMOND VIRGINIA) DATED SEPTEMBER 14, 2012,  
25 SPECIFYING THE TYPE OF COMMUNITY LABOR PERFORMED AND THE NUMBER OF DAYS (202) THE  
26 PROBATIONER COMPLETED.

27 THE INTERSTATE COMPACT OFFICER IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA  
28 CONDUCTED A FIELD RESIDENCE/ADDRESS VERIFICATION ON SEPTEMBER 20, 2012. THE  
PROBATIONER WAS PRESENT DURING THIS RESIDENTIAL/ADDRESS VERIFICATION AND PROVIDED

1 THE PROBATION OFFICER WITH A CALIFORNIA IDENTIFICATION CARD INDICATING THE CALIFORNIA  
2 ADDRESS: 2738 RINCONIA DR. LOS ANGELES, CA., 90068

3 **DEFENDANT'S STATEMENT:**

4 THE INTERSTATE COMPACT OFFICER IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RECEIVED  
5 A TELEPHONE CALL FROM A CALLER ON SEPTEMBER 17, 2012, WHO IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS  
6 "CHRISTOPHER BROWN" AND CONFIRMED IDENTIFYING INFORMATION IE: BIRTHDATE AND SOCIAL  
7 SECURITY NUMBER. THE PROBATION OFFICER INFORMED THE PROBATIONER THAT INFORMATION  
8 GIVEN DURING THIS TELEPHONE INTERVIEW COULD AND WOULD BE USED IN THIS REPORT.

9 IN REGARDS TO THE PROBATIONER'S FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE TRAVEL  
10 REQUIREMENTS IN THE STATE OF VIRGINIA, HE GAVE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: HE CALLED THE  
11 PROBATION OFFICER AND HE INFORMED HER OF HIS DEPARTURE TO PARIS AND CALLED AGAIN  
12 UPON HIS RETURN FROM PARIS. THE PROBATIONER STATED THIS WAS THE PROCEDURE HE HAD USED  
13 ON HIS PRIOR TRAVEL COMMITMENTS. REGARDING THE USE OF MARIJUANA THE PROBATIONER  
14 STATED HE USED MARIJUANA WHILE HE WAS IN LOS ANGELES. THE PROBATIONER FURTHER  
15 INDICATED HE HAD NO KNOWLEDGE OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE OF VIRGINIA  
16 REGARDING MARIJUANA USAGE. THE PROBATIONER EMPHASIZED DURING THE TELEPHONE  
17 INTERVIEW, HIS PRIMARY RESIDENCE IS IN THE STATE OF VIRGINIA. ALTHOUGH, HE HAS A HOME IN  
18 LOS ANGELES THIS RESIDENCE IS FOR WORK PURPOSE ONLY. IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE, THE  
19 PROBATIONER EXPRESSED A DESIRE TO FULLY COMPLY WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF  
20 THIS PROBATION GRANT AND IS HOPEFUL THE PROBATION GRANT WILL BE MODIFIED TO A GRANT  
21 WITHOUT FORMAL SUPERVISION.

22 **EVALUATION:**

23 BASED ON THE INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF  
24 VIRGINIA, TELEPHONE INTERVIEW WITH THE PROBATIONER, PROBATION RECORDS AND THE  
25 RESIDENTIAL/ADDRESS VISIT; IT APPEARS THE DEFENDANT IS MAKING AN EFFORT TO COMPLY WITH  
26 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PROBATION WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE POSITIVE MARIJUANA TEST  
27 AND THE FAILURE TO OBTAIN PERMISSION TO TRAVEL.

28 THE PROBATIONER HAS COMPLETED A 52-WEEK DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM, HAS PAID ALL  
COURT ORDERED FEES AND HAS NOT SUSTAINED ANY NEW ARRESTS.

RECOMMENDATION:

2 IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE PROBATIONER BE FOUND IN VIOLATION OF  
3 PROBATION; THAT PROBATION BE CONTINUED ON THE RECOMMENDED MODIFIED TERMS AND  
4 CONDITIONS TO REFLECT THE PROBATIONER IS ORDERED NOT TO USE MARIJUANA IN ANY STATE,  
5 THE PROBATIONER IS ORDERED TO OBTAIN TRAVEL CREDENTIALS, ADHERE TO RULES AND  
6 REGULATIONS REGARDING TRAVELING, AND THAT ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS TO REMAIN  
7 THE SAME.

Within the last two months, there have been two incidents involving Mr. Brown. On June 18, 2012, Mr. Brown tested positive for marijuana. Mr. Brown produced a card from an acupuncturist, Ketino Karakalidi, authorizing the medical use of marijuana. It was explained to Mr. Brown that the Commonwealth of Virginia has no laws permitting the use of marijuana in any form and that would not be permitted while on supervision in Virginia.

Secondly, it is required of probationers leaving the state to sign a travel permit and to contact the probation officer when they arrive back at home. Mr. Brown is very familiar with this procedure given his schedule. Prior to leaving for his court authorized trip to Paris on July 22, 2012, Mr. Brown was instructed to report to the probation office to sign and receive his travel permit. He never reported and left for Paris and returned back to Virginia without contacting the probation office.

Mr. Brown's recent actions place him in violation of his court ordered supervision.

To date, Mr. Brown has 121 hours of community service remaining to complete. Our office recommends that his community service requirement be reassigned from the Richmond City Police Department to the probation office.
