12	DESCRIBED THE KEY AND ITS CHAIN TO THE OFFICERS WHO THEN CONDUCTED A FOLLOW-UP AT THE
13	HOLLYWOOD STATION. WHEN THE OFFICERS REVIEWED ALL THE ITEMS THAT WERE BOOKED AS PERSONAL
