I do not want to condone more violence in the prison system, so I hope you got him good enough that you can remain calm the rest of your time on the inside. I am tossing \$50.00 on your books. This is my way of saying thank you for standing up for the children that are victims to scumbags like Fogle. Please keep your head up and your chest out and know that there are folks on the outside that appreciate your stance on this issue. I think it should happen more often, but do not want to advocate more problems for correctional officers as I have many that are friends of mine that I love and respect. I was a victim of sexual abuse at a young age and wish I had someone like you in my corner back then. Stay safe Sir!
