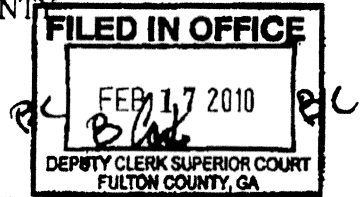

**COMPLAINT FOR DIVORCE**

COMES NOW the Petitioner, T. Y. NASH, and for his Complaint for Divorce against the Respondent, C. FLORES, shows this Honorable Court as follows:

1.  
Petitioner is a resident of the State of Georgia and has been for more than six (6) months preceding the filing of this Complaint for divorce.

Respondent has acknowledged service of process.

Venue and jurisdiction in this Court is proper.

The parties are Husband and Wife, having been married on or about September 4, 2009. The parties separated prior to the filing of this Complaint for Divorce, and are currently living in a bona fide state of separation.

Petitioner brings this Complaint for Divorce upon the ground that the marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken as defined in O.C.G.A. § 19-5-3(13). There is no hope for reconciliation.

There are currently no minor children born as a result of this marriage.



The parties anticipate entering into a comprehensive agreement which will resolve all issues between them, which Petitioner prays be incorporated into the Final Judgment and Decree of Divorce.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the Court grant him the following relief:

- (a) that Petitioner be granted a total divorce, that is, a divorce *a vinculo matrimonii*, upon legal principles;
- (b) that the agreement between the parties be approved by this Court and incorporated into the Final Judgment and Decree of Divorce; and
- (c) that the Court award such other relief as is equitable and appropriate.
