On 7-24-2007, at approximately 0134 hours, I, Officer Joseph Cortez #3610, was working morning watch uniform patrol assigned to 4L6. I responded to the City of Santa Monica Civic Center parking lot, 1855 Main Street, and assisted Officer Robert D'Andrea with his driving under the Influence (DUI) investigation.

After Officer D'Andrea determined Lindsay Lohan was driving under the influence of alcohol I assisted him in placing Lohan in handcuffs. I then followed Officer D'Andrea, who was transporting Lohan, to the Santa Monica Police Department Jail. Once at the Santa Monica Police Department Jail I checked the time. I noted the time to be 0218 hours. I continuously observed Lohan for 15 minutes. During this observation time Lohan did not ingest alcohol or liquids, eat, smoke, or vomit.

While I was observing Lohan, Officer Marilyn Amiache #3517 was conducting her custody search. During this search I observed Officer Amiache pull a paper bindle out of Lohan's right rear pant pocket. I observed Officer Amiache open the bindle and look at its contents. Officer Amiache handed the bindle to Officer D'Andrea and I observed an off-white powder substance inside. I observed a large portion of the substance fall from the bindle and land on the floor.

After 15 minutes of continuous observation I walked Lohan to the Datamaster cdm breath analysis machine. I explained to Lohan the breath analysis process. I had Lohan provide two breath samples and obtained the results. The test showed that Lohan had a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of .12 and .13 respectfully. I completed the Datamaster cdm checklist, attached the printed results. Lohan was then placed in holding cell 68.

Officer D'Andrea handed me the paper bindle and asked me to complete a WELLS test on the substance found inside. I had Forensics Specialist Cynthia Vasquez #2685 photograph the bindle and its contents. I then scrapped the contents out of the bindle and weighed it. I noted the weight to be .05 grams. I then took a small sample of the contents and completed a WELLS test. This test was positive for cocaine. I packaged the cocaine, sealed the envelope and booked it into evidence.

I advised Officer D'Andrea of my findings and provided him with this supplemental report. For further information regarding this incident, please refer to Officer D'Andrea's report.

It should be noted that I am certified through the Los Angeles County Sheriffs Department Forensics Units to conduct WELLS test on narcotics as well as complete Blood Alcohol screening with the Datamaster cdm.
