15 11/02/2011, WHICH IS REFLECTED IN THE TIME SHEET. THE PROBATIONER  
16 STATED SHE PLANS TO COMPLETE AN ADDITIONAL DAY ON 12/13/2011. MARINA  
17 AT THE VOLUNTEER CENTER ADVISED THAT THEIR RECORDS HAD SHOWN THE  
18 PROBATIONER IS STILL REQUIRED TO DO COMMUNITY SERVICE AT THE  
19 SHELTER; HOWEVER, HER SUPERVISOR CLARIFIED WITH THE COURT THAT HER  
20 REMAINING HOURS ARE TO BE COMPLETED AT THE MORGUE.

21 THE PROBATION OFFICER ALSO SPOKE TO TRUDY MURPHY AT THE MORGUE, WHO  
22 VERIFIED THE PROBATIONER COMPLETED (12) DAYS OF SERVICE.
