On 9-27-10 at 2354, I was dispatched to 12436 Ft. Caroline Road in reference to an aggravated battery incident.

Upon arrival I learned that the suspect entered the listed residence, (the home of his ex-girlfriend/victim #1), and held her and victim #2 at gunpoint, against their will.

I also learned that the suspect battered/pistol whipped both victims and fired shots at victim #1.

Multiple units responded to the scene and eventually cleared the home, confirming that the suspect had fled the scene.

Lt. C.R. Phelps #5425 and Sgt. T.W. Riggs #7255 also respond to the scene.

The victim's gave the following account of the incident.

The victims advised that they were watching television, in the second floor game room at the listed location, when they were startled by the suspect entering the room with some form of plastic grocery type bag covering

The suspect pointed a semi-automatic handgun at the two victims as he began yelling at them. The suspect stated "I can't believe that your with this guy" as he became abusive toward victim #1. The suspect grabbed victim #1 by the hair and pulled her around as he hit her numerous times with his fists and with the handgun.

The suspect then utilized the handgun to strike victim #2 in the back of his head.

The suspect took victim #1's cell phone from her, denying her the ability to call for help.

Victim #1 attempted to flee, however, the suspect tackled her and held her at gunpoint. It was at this time that the suspect held the gun to her head and quoted a recent movie/news event, saying " what did that football player tell his girlfriend, its a good day to die".

Victim #1 stated that the suspect also struck her dog several times.

The suspect then told the victims that he was going to have to kill them if he wanted to get out safe.

The suspect then asked victim #2 where he lived as he continued to yell at both victims.

The suspect then asked victim #2 if he had had sex with victim #1.

The suspect then told victim #1 to "suck my dick and suck his dick", making reference to victim #2.

The suspect then pointed the gun at victim #2 and said, "tell me you fucked her".

The victims were then told to sit down, which they did on the steps which lead to the game room.

Victim #1 was petting her dog when she chose to stand up and run down the hall. She then jumped over a balcony from the second floor to the ground floor where she knew there was a gun.

Victim #2 placed a chair under the game room door, not allowing it to open, and jumped from the second story

window to the ground outside. He then ran to a neighbouring home and called the police.

Victim #1 retrieved the gun while the suspect ran down the stairs toward her.

The suspect told victim #1 he loved her as he approached her with gun in hand. Victim #1 then pointed her gun at him. The gun had a laser dot which illuminated on the suspect. The suspect then fired a shot. In self defense victim #1 fired a shot.

The suspect then fled.

Victim #1 returned to her upstairs bedroom and called the police.

Victim #1 then looked outside and saw the police and exited.

The victim's stated that throughout the time that the suspect was present, approximately 40 minutes, he made comments about not leaving any fingerprints.

The suspect violated the following conditions of the injunction, (ORDER NO: 2010 DR 1277 DV/CASE NO: C1326960 - INJUNCTION SERVED 5/5/10):

CONDITIONS: 01 - THE SUBJECT IS RESTRAINED FROM ASSAULTING, THREATENING, ABUSING, HARASSING, FOLLOWING, INTERFERING WITH, OR STALKING THE PROTECTED PERSON AND/OR THE CHILD OF THE PROTECTED PERSON

CONDITIONS: 04 - THE SUBJECT IS REQUIRED TO STAY AWAY FROM THE RESIDENCE, PROPERTY, SCHOOL, OR PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT OF THE PROTECTED PERSON OR OTHER FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBER

CONDITIONS: 05 - THE SUBJECT IS RESTRAINED FROM COMMUNICATING WITH THE PROTECTED PERSON INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PERSONAL, WRITTEN, OR TELEPHONE CONTACT, OR ANYONE WITH WHOM THE COMMUNICATION WOULD BE LIKELY TO CAUSE ANNOYANCE OR ALARM THE VICTIM

CONDITIONS: 07 - THE SUBJECT IS PROHIBITED FROM POSSESSING AND/OR PURCHASING A FIREARM OR OTHER WEAPON

Victim #1's cellphone was taking from the scene by the suspect.

Officers then went to the suspect's residence where he was taken into custody without incident.

The suspect was advised of his Miranda Rights via rights card. Post Miranda, the suspect chose to remain silent and requested to talk to his attorney.

Due to the suspect invoking his right to remain silent, no detective was called to the scene.

The suspect was subsequently arrested and transported to the PTDF.
