

1 **REASON FOR HEARING:**

2 THE MATTER WAS LAST BEFORE THE COURT ON AUGUST 3, 2015, AND WAS  
3 CONTINUED TO THE INSTANT DATE FOR A SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT REGARDING  
4 THE DEFENDANT'S PROGRESS ON PROBATION.

5 **RECORD BUREAU CLEARANCE:**

6 THIS CASE HAS BEEN REGISTERED WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF  
7 JUSTICE, BUREAU OF CRIMINAL IDENTIFICATION AND INVESTIGATION (CII).  
8 A CHECK WITH THIS AGENCY, FBI RECORDS AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT  
9 AGENCIES REVEALED NO NEW ARRESTS.

10 **REPORT:**

11 THE PROBATIONER IS CURRENTLY IN COMPLIANCE.

12 **FINANCIAL INFORMATION:**

13 THE PROBATIONER'S TOTAL FINANCIAL OBLIGATION IS \$2,170.00.

14 THE BALANCE IS \$0.00.

15 THE DEFENDANT'S FINANCIAL OBLIGATION IS PAID IN FULL AS OF FEBRUARY

1 26, 2015. THE COURT ORDERED RESTITUTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$80,900.00  
2 WAS PAID DIRECTLY TO THE VICTIM THROUGH THE DEFENSE COUNSEL ON  
3 AUGUST 21, 2014.

4 THE DEFENDANT APPEARS TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE TERMS AND  
5 CONDITIONS OF PROBATION. THE DEFENDANT HAS NOT INCURRED ANY NEW  
6 ARRESTS SINCE THE LAST COURT HEARING, AND HE CONTINUES TO REPORT TO  
7 THE PROBATION DEPARTMENT, ON A MONTHLY BASIS, AS DIRECTED; HE LAST  
8 REPORTED IN PERSON ON OCTOBER 13, 2015. AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED, THE  
9 DEFENDANT ATTENDED 12 SESSIONS OF ANGER MANAGEMENT COUNSELING, AND  
10 HAS SINCE COMPLETED 40 HOURS OF COMMUNITY LABOR WITH VOLUNTEERS OF  
11 AMERICA'S FAMILY HOMELESS SHELTER AND THE GANG REDUCTION & YOUTH  
12 DEVELOPMENT CENTER. A LETTER AND TIME-SHEET FROM VOLUNTEERS OF  
13 AMERICA (VOA), DATED OCTOBER 19, 2015, WILL BE PROVIDED TO THE COURT  
14 BY THE DEFENSE COUNSEL. ACCORDING TO MR. GOMEZ, PROGRAM MANAGER OF  
15 THE HOMELESS SHELTER, THE DEFENDANT HAD NO PROBLEM "GETTING HIS  
16 HANDS DIRTY" PERFORMING MAINTENANCE AND JANITORIAL WORK.

17 REMARKS:

18 THE DEFENDANT APPEARS TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH ALL TERMS AND  
19 CONDITIONS OF PROBATION. THEREFORE, IF THE COURT IS STILL INCLINED  
20 TO CONVERT THE DEFENDANT'S FORMAL PROBATION TO INFORMAL PROBATION,  
21 AS STATED IN THE SENTENCING MINUTE ORDER DATED JULY 9, 2014, THE  
22 PROBATION OFFICER WOULD NOT OBJECT. IN VIEW OF THE ABOVE CITED  
23 INFORMATION, THE FOLLOWING RECOMMENDATION IS MADE.

1 RECOMMENDATIONS:

2 IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT PROBATION BE CONTINUED ON ORIGINAL TERMS AND  
3 CONDITIONS.
