FACTUAL CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING ARREST OR INCIDENT:

ON 01/27/2010 AT APPROXIMATELY 0240 HOURS OFFICER J. MONSON, #19802 AND PARTNER OFFICER J. GREENGARD, #19192, WERE ON PATROL IN THE WEST LOS ANGELES AREA IN A FULLY MARKED BLACK AND WHITE CHP PATROL VEHICLE WHEN THEY OBSERVED A WHITE FORD F-150 TRUCK TRAVELING SOUTHBOUND ON INTERSTATE 405 AT SANTA MONICA BLVD. AT APPROXIMATELY 94 MILES PER HOUR. THE OFFICERS OBSERVED THE F-150 WAS STRADDLING THE #3 AND #4 LANE. OFFICER MONSON AND OFFICER GREENGARD INITIATED AN ENFORCEMENT STOP AND CONTACTED THE MALE DRIVER, ADRIAN PASDAR. UPON CONTACTING PASDAR, THE OFFICERS NOTICED AN ODOR OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE EMITTING FROM THE WITHIN THE VEHICLE. OFFICER MONSON THEN CONDUCTED A DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE INVESTIGATION AND DETERMINED THAT PASDAR WAS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL. PASDAR WAS ARRESTED AT 0259 HOURS AND SUBSEQUENTLY BOOKED INTO THE LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT PACIFIC DIVISION JAIL ON 01/27/2010 AT 0422 HOURS. THE OFFICER IN CHARGE, M. RADILLO, 17923, WAS NOTIFIED.
