On 6-24-2012 at 0531 hours I responded to [REDACTED] in reference to a suspicious person call. Before arrival Officer Roden asked dispatch if this was a return call from 6-23-2012 and we were advised that it was a return call, involving the same black female. Officer McGinn filled out a criminal trespass warning on 6-23-2012 to a black female, (Darshelle Jones-Rakestraw) Ms.Jones-Rakestraw signed the warning. On arrival I noticed a black female sitting on the front porch of the listed location using her I-pad which was plugged into a house outlet. I was able to confirm the black female as being Ms. Jones-Rakestraw by her Ohio ID card. I asked her if she was on the property yesterday and she would not answer. I placed Ms. Jones-Rakestraw under arrest and put her in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

I spoke to the complainant, Mr. Raymond and he stated that the female was on his property on 6-23-2012 and was asked to leave and not come back onto the property. Mr. Raymond stated that he noticed the female on the front porch by his outside video and called police.

Ms. Jones-Rakestraw was transported to the Alpharetta Jail but the on duty supervisor refused admittance because of her mental state. Ms. Jones-Rakestraw was saying that she was the wife of Mr. Raymond and he makes all her decisions. I then transported Ms. Jones-Rakestraw to Emory Johns Creek Hospital for a mental and physical evaluation. Dr. [REDACTED] signed a 10-13 form and admitted Ms. Jones-Rakestraw to the hospital for mental evaluation. Ms. Jones-Rakestraw was released on a copy of charges at Emory Johns Creek Hospital, court date
