

At this time, according to our contracts with the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs for the State of California and the Department of Health Services for the County of Los Angeles, Lindsey is in program compliance. 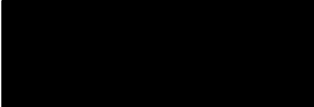

This is a follow up to the progress report issued on May 4, 2010 regarding Lindsey's progress in our SB18 program. Lindsey transferred to our program on March 16, 2009. She transferred in with credit for 3 hours of education, 11 group sessions, 13 face to face interviews and 4 AA meetings. This is approximately six months of program activity.

We agreed to see her in private sessions as her presence in a group setting prohibited any self-disclosure. The media frenzy that arrives with her brings an element of chaos and confusion so this seemed to be a solution for both her anonymity and our other clients. In the beginning, she struggled with consistency and punctuality in attending her scheduled activities. We returned her case to court for failing to obtain a leave of absence for a work related trip. [Redacted]

Her court appearance with you on December 15, 2009 made a difference in her sense of responsibility toward her program obligations.

She now attends regularly and consistently communicates in a timely manner to reschedule if necessary. Her attitude is positive and receptive to ideas regarding lifestyle changes. She has never come under the influence, been rude or disrespectful.

We non-comply clients for coming under the influence, no contact for 21 days without an approved leave of absence, failure to complete by a court ordered date, threatening violence, possessing a weapon or a subsequent arrest. "Program sobriety" requires attending class substance free.
